



# Little Mother Makes a SWIM SUIT For Terri Lee




## Materials:

$\frac{1}{4}$  yard jersey knit fabric,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide elastic  
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide satin ribbon, White wool felt

## Instructions:

1. Trace pattern from DC and cut out. Tape A to B to make a one-piece pattern. Cut out 1 on fold of fabric.
2. Double fold top of BACK and insert a 3" piece of elastic, taking at both sides.
3. Stitch a small turned edge at top of from and add 10: pieces of ribbon at the "X" mark.
4. Stitch a small turned edge around leg openings, stitch side seams.
5. Take a piece of felt,  $5/8$ " by  $\frac{3}{4}$ " and cut into a "T". Stitch or glue on suit.


While the 1952 Catalog continued to display the wool jersey swimsuit, I whole heartedly believe that the Spandex suit with its pleated trim on the bodice is the suit we associate with this year. The May Monthly booklet proudly presents it on the cover.

A simple bathing suit decorated with a pleated trim on the bodice, a ribbon tie finished with an elastic gather at the back waistline. Jerri also has a matching set of trunks and I might add in as many colors as were made for Terri. For low price of \$1.00 the ever-popular Ester Williams and Tarzan would have been proud own these suits.

Spandex by the way was invented by a chemist working for Dupont which was developed as a replacement for rubber. It was an expensive stretchy, form fitting fabric at the time which the Terri Lee Co. made good use of for our dolls bathing suits.

While the last warm days are slowly leaving Texas, Terri Lee still enjoys swimming in the pool at her home. Having just purchased a new swim suit it was different from all the others she owned she wanted to show it off. Terri had posed for the cover of the May 1953 Monthly Magazine with Jerri Lee and Linda baby, however that swim suit like all her others was a solid color. In the June 1953 Monthly Magazine Terri is a paper doll wearing this swimsuit. There is no mention of stock number or price in either magazines. While the solid colors are beautiful and come in all shades of pink, red, purple, blue, and green, as

This swimsuit is a hard one to point to an exact date. There are no pictures in either the Fashion Parade or the Monthly Magazines. The spandex puts the swimsuit in the 1953 range, but the spandex swimsuit is a one piece while the pattern on this swimsuit is the same as the fish and dot swimsuit. This swimsuit as well as the fish and dot swimsuits have both printed and embroidery tags. If I had to guess, I would put it after the spandex swimsuit and before the fish and dot swimsuit. While it has the same pattern the fabric is different. I have this swimsuit in four colors, red, pink, turquoise, and brown. The white swimsuit below looks the most like the fish and dot swimwear.

The new swim suit made of cotton, is often found in the purple and orange fish pattern with contrasting trim at top and hip area. The legs are gathered. Ribbon is again used for neck tie.

Jerri's trunks have elastic at the waist.

A matching beach coat is now introduced and is usually made of the solid trim material with contrasting pockets.

Mid-year, the July Monthly booklet presents the most fashionable of suits! The embossed large Polka Dot suit! See the next two pages for more about this glamour beach set.

# 1954 - 1955 - Swimwear

The 1954 Fashion Parade gives us two swimsuit varieties to choose from, the fish swimsuit and the dot swimsuit. Both are wonderful examples of swimsuit styles of the 1950s. Both swimsuits are from the same pattern, it's the fabric that gives each suit a different look. The first style is what I call the dot swimwear. In the Fashion Parade the swimsuit for Terri is sold as a set with the beach coat, item # 3520E for \$1.95 while Jerri's swim trunks is item #4510A and costs \$1.00.

The dot swim wear was also on the July 1954 Monthly Magazine The swimsuit alone costs \$1.00 for either Terri or Jerri. There is no item number to select, just a check by the item and enclosing money would ensure delivery. There is no item number, it is simply called Swimsuit Alone \$1.00 or Jerri's Swim Trunks Alone \$1.00. If you wanted to purchase the swimwear on a doll each would cost \$11.95. Jerri's swim trunks are made from the same fabric, I have only seen his in the solid color which matches Terri's. Colors I have found are red, green, and pink all with dots in a gold metallic stripped background. If you look at the Monthly Magazine, the matching jacket is pictured on the ground. There is no mention of a beach jacket in the price list so it must have been included in the Swim Kit for \$4.95. Both of my beach coats have the dot fabric coat and the solid fabric for pockets. However, the Fashion Parade shows the opposite available with the coat in the solid color and the pockets made from the dot fabric. In the 2005 Convention photo there is a solid green beach coat. The fabric has a crinkle texture with a gold or silver line through the fabric around the dots.

In 1955 Tiny Terri lee was introduced and soon was wearing the same outfits as Terri Lee. In the Tiny Terri Lee Fashion parade of 1956 Tiny Terri & Jerri Lee is seen in their swimwear. You could purchase TTL for \$4.19 or TJL for \$3.79 there was also an option to purchase the outfit only for \$.69 for TTL or \$.29 for TJL. Also included in the 1956 Fashion Parade is the beach coat for TTL, costing \$1.49.

I have the pair in navy blue and have the outfit in red as well. I have a MIP pink swimsuit for TTL.

As seen in the picture there are two styles for TJL's swim trunks, one with white fabric down the sides and the other trunks without.

Another swimsuit for TTL that I have not found advertised is a white swimsuit made of spandex that came with a very ornate beach jacket. I have the jacket in two colors.



The last swimsuit for TTL is a white satin fabric which is constructed the same way as the white swimsuit on the page before, only this one has a fancy flair. A fur trim. Not very practical for swimming. Maybe this was her sunbathing suit only?

**Materials:**

1/4 yard cotton fabric  
1/4" elastic 9" in length

- ♥ Cut 2 fronts and 2 backs
- ♥ Use the side seams as grain direction.
- ♥ Sew all Seams  $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless stated otherwise

**Sewing Instructions:**

1. Stitch Center Front (C.F.) seam
2. Stitch Front to back at side seams
3. Fold waistline  $\frac{1}{8}$ " and fold again  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch in place at inner edge to form a casing
4. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " elastic 9" long. Insert into waistline casing. Tack ends of elastic to fabric to hold in place
5. Fold hemline  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and fold again  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Stitch in place
6. Stitch center back (C.B.) seam
7. Stitch crotch seam (seam between legs)

**You can add a stripe down the side if desired. Have fun!**

There is still time for the beach! Terri and Jerri are headed off for some late summer fun. They have their floaties and towels. What a splash-tacular time, the water is still warm and our brother and sister pair are packed and ready to go including their zinc-oxide for nose protection and Coppertone. Jerri actually played a trick on Terri at the beach and got away with it. He wrote "Terri Lee" on her back in Vaseline before he slathered her in Coppertone. I guess that's how the words "Terri Lee" appeared between her shoulder blades...What a rascal that Jerri is.

## BEACH TOWELS:

While hunting for a Wool Jersey swimsuit I found 4 different beach towels. The oldest ones with the Printed Tags are from the early Apple Valley era. The ones in my collection are solid colors – pink or aqua terry cloth. 18" x 8.5"

The Embroidered Tags are generally found on the white terry cloth with a colored thread (red, blue or?) overcasting on the edges. These would be for your hard plastic 1952 -1956 dolls.

## SWIM RINGS aka Floaties:

They are found in a variety of colors: White with a solid red, blue, yellow, green on reverse side. Also found with a yellow top color with a blue solid reverse. Most certainly there are more colors to be found. Pat Rather notes that the swim ring on cover of May 1953 Monthly Magazine is different than what we have found, notice where the air-input is located, a prototype perhaps?

Swim rings are all identified on the face with **"terri lee"**. 11.5" diameter

## BANDANA:

Let's not forget that Terri needed to keep her hair neat. She has a plastic Bandana. Our dotted Swiss plastic Bandana is a triangle with the widest part at 25" x 18" length to the point. Bottom to tippy top is 12.5" tall. This was sold in the Gift Combination sets or a dressed Terri #510A in swim suit with Sunglasses and Bandana. I have 3 bandanas and they are all pink. I know there are yellow and green bandanas out there if anyone is up for a trade.

Reviewing all the price lists and monthly booklets it is my assumption that the beach towels and Bandanas were sold exclusively as a part of the Gift Sets unlike the Swim Rings which could be purchased individually.



The Terry Cloth beach towel sold in the complete set usually came in white and is stitched around the edge to match the swimsuit. As seen in the pictures they are tagged.

Different colored beach towels are also available. The stitching matches the color of the towel. These towels are not tagged, but are the same size as the tagged towels.

The colored towels may be a generic accessory, but they complement Terri's non Terry Cloth swim suits.



# Little Mother Sews a Beach Towel for Terri Lee

Terri Lee is missing her beach towel. Let's make her a new one.

## Materials:

Piece of Terry Cloth 17" x 8 1/2"  
Contrasting thread

## Instructions:

You can buy terry cloth by the yard at a fabric store or you can use a hand towel. You will then Cut a rectangle 17" long by 8 1/2" wide.


There are many ways to finish the edge of your terry cloth rectangle.

For this project I have used a Serger, some of you might own one or have a friend who owns one. The serged edge is most practical and will look like the original beach towel that came in the "Let's go swimming" bag.

If you do not have a serger, you can finish the edge on a sewing machine with a zig zag stitch. Some newer sewing machines have a built in serger edge.

If you do not have a sewing machine you can finish the edge by hand using a blanket stitch.
